Luke 14:15-24 (NLT)

"Hearing this, a man sitting at the table with Jesus exclaimed, "What a blessing it will be to attend a banquet in the Kingdom of God!" Jesus replied with this story: "A man prepared a great feast and sent out many invitations. When the banquet was ready, he sent his servant to tell the guests, 'Come, the banquet is ready.' But they all began making excuses. One said, 'I have just bought a field and must inspect it. Please excuse me.' Another said, 'I have just bought five pairs of oxen, and I want to try them out. Please excuse me.' Another said, 'I now have a wife, so I can't come.' "The servant returned and told his master what they had said. His master was furious and said, 'Go quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and invite the poor, the crippled, the blind, and the lame.' After the servant had done this, he reported, 'There is still room for more.' So his master said, 'Go out into the country lanes and behind the hedges and urge anyone you find to come, so that the house will be full. For

none of those I first invited will get even the smallest taste of my banquet.'"

Those who tolerate an empty church or half-filled church house will never experience dynamic church growth.

Luke 14:23 (NKJV)

"Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.'"

Dynamic church growth is not possible without a system that compels people to come.



There are different types of Church Growth Systems. Some are Godly and some are Ungodly.

A Lukewarm Church Entertainment System

Revelation 3:14-20 NKJV — “And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, ‘These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: “I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot. “So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth. “Because you say, ‘I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing’—and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked— “I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire, that you may be rich; and white garments, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see. “As many as I love, I rebuke and

chasten. Therefore be zealous and repent. “Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.”

You make people's flesh comfortable and entertained to keep them coming to church in their numbers.

Temple and House to House Outreach System

Revelation 3:7-11 NKJV — “And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, ‘These things says He who is holy, He who is true, “He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens”: “I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

"Indeed I will make those of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie—indeed I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you. "Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth. "Behold, I am coming quickly! Hold fast what you have, that no one may take your crown."

Acts 2:46-47 NKJV — "So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved."

This system is built on the corporate word and anointing in the Temple Services and evangelism, fellowship and discipleship house to house.

The Early Apostles of our Lord Jesus used this Temple and House System to compel people to come.

Scriptural Examples

Acts 5:12-16 NLT — "The apostles were performing many miraculous signs and wonders among the people. And all the believers were meeting regularly at the Temple in the area known as Solomon's Colonnade. But no one else dared to join them, even though all the people had high

regard for them. Yet more and more people believed and were brought to the Lord—crowds of both men and women. As a result of the apostles' work, sick people were brought out into the streets on beds and mats so that Peter's shadow might fall across some of them as he went by. Crowds came from the villages around Jerusalem, bringing their sick and those possessed by evil spirits, and they were all healed."

Acts 4:31 NKJV — "And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness."

Acts 2:46 NKJV — "So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart."

Acts 20:20 NKJV — "How I kept back nothing that was helpful, but proclaimed it to you, and taught you publicly and from house to house."

Romans 16:5 NKJV — "Likewise greet the church that is in their house. Greet my beloved Epaenetus, who is the firstfruits of Achaia to Christ."

Philemon 1:2 NKJV — "To the beloved Apphia, Archippus our fellow soldier, and to the church in your house."



The leadership of this Temple and House System is comprised of Temple Fellowship Leaders, House Fellowship Leaders and Leadership Hybrids.

You are either a minister in the Temple Services, House Services or both according to the Lord Jesus' plan for you.

At DVA from February 2023, we will be incorporating the Temple and House System.

Church Brand System

Revelation 3:1 NKJV — “And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, ‘These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: “I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.”

You have a name and identity of distinction that attracts people .



MODULE TWO

The Ministry of a Cell Group Leader

2 Samuel 6:10-12 NLT — "So David decided not to move the Ark of the LORD into the City of David. Instead, he took it to the house of Obed-edom of Gath. The Ark of the LORD remained there in Obed-edom's house for three months, and the LORD blessed Obed-edom and his entire household. Then King David was told, "The LORD has blessed Obed-edom's household and everything he has because of the Ark of God." So David went there and brought the Ark of God from the house of Obed-edom to the City of David with a great celebration."

1 Chronicles 15:18 NLT — "The following men were chosen as their assistants: Zechariah, Jaaziel, Shemiramoth, Jehiel, Unni, Eliab, Benaiah, Maaseiah, Mattithiah, Eliphelehu, Mikneiah, and the gatekeepers—Obed-edom and Jeiel."

Function

- 1. A Host of the DVA Anointing** in their home or personal fellowship setting
- 2. A Gatekeeper** that opens the door for people to experience the DVA message and grace
- 3. A Soul Winner: Daniel 12:3 NKJV** — "Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever."
- 4. A Discippler of Others: Matthew 28:18-20 NLT** — "Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."



MODULE THREE

The Qualities of a Cell Group Leader

1. Have the DNA of the Man of God and Ministry.

The LORD Jesus came in the spiritual DNA of Abraham and David.

Matthew 1:1 NKJV — "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham."

Matthew 1:20 NKJV — But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit."

Joseph, the LORD Jesus' stepfather was a spiritual son of David.

Matthew 1:20 NKJV — "But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your

wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit."

John came in the spirit and power of Elijah

2 Kings 2:15 NKJV — "Now when the sons of the prophets who were from Jericho saw him, they said, "The spirit of Elijah rests on Elisha." And they came to meet him, and bowed to the ground before him."

Luke 1:17 NKJV — "He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, 'to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,' and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready a people prepared for the Lord."

2. Must have a heart to host the DVA anointing in their home or place of personal fellowship.



MODULE THREE

3. Must be hospitable.

Romans 12:13 NKJV — "Distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality."

4. A wise person.

5. Sensitive to the flow of the Holy Spirit.

6. A good reputation among the saints.

7. Able to communicate the word of God.



MODULE FOUR

The Dynamics of the DVA Cell System

1. Prophet designs the Prophetic Study Outlines for the month.
2. Cell Group leaders are trained in the study beforehand.
3. Cell Groups are evangelistic, discipleship and supportive.
4. Cell groups are setup in different parishes.
5. Cell group leaders invite people from their circle of relationships.
6. DVA members attend cell group in their parish.
7. DVA members invite their relationship circles to attend local cell group with them.
8. Cell Group leaders disciple all attendees in the message and grace of the ministry.
9. Cell Group leaders lead members in providing prayer, love and support for the needs of the Cell Group members.
10. Cell Group leaders ensure all members come to Sunday and Wednesday services according to availability.
